Syllabus and Question Pattern for PET for admission in the Academic year 2021-22

PET will be an online examination consist of a 100 marks- multiple-choice-type question paper, comprised of 50 questions in total. 25 questions shall contain general knowledge, research methodology and aptitude related questions (Section-A) whereas 25 questions shall be shall be subject specific (Section-B). The qualifying marks for the PET shall be 55.

1. The syllabus for the subject specific part (Section B) of the PET shall be equivalent to of the syllabus of the concerned subject covered in the UGC-NET examination held on 24 Sept – 13 Nov. 2020.
2. For the Section A of the examination comprised of General knowledge, research methodology and aptitude related questions, the following topics shall be covered
 - A. **General Knowledge:** Current affairs, General information about India and World, Fundamentals of Computer
 - B. **Research Methodology:** Methods of data collection, Data types and analysis techniques, Statistical Methods (Central Tendency and variance), Theory and Hypotheses, Editing tools, Computer based tools, Literature survey.
 - C. **Aptitude:** Quantitative Aptitude, Logical Reasoning, Comprehension and Composition of sentence fragments.
